Sunset Lamps

These can however range from 20 euros up to 130 euros depending on the type of color technology.

Personally, I will be getting the basic version, as it's affordable and I think that having a slight sunset color is so relaxing, and it could also be a nice touch to use in photos.





Pumpkin Recipe

Of course, fitting for Halloween and autumn pumpkins are in season. There are so many delicious recipes, like a traditional pumpkin soup, but if you want to try something a little different **my neighbor's pumpkin ravioli** is the way to go.

For a four-person portion, you'll need to start by mixing 400g of flour, with four eggs and a little salt into a smooth dough. Wrap the finished dough in cling film and let it rest in the fridge for one hour.



During this, peel and cut a crookneck pumpkin into slices and put these in the oven, on a baking tray, for 40 min at 180°C. When finished and cooled, puree the pumpkin together with five amaretti biscuits, a handful of mustard fruits, nutmeg, 100g of parmesan, and salt + pepper.

Then roll the dough out into a sheet, and place a tee spoon of the filling you just made about every five centimeters. Cover this with a second rolled sheet of dough, then cut the pieces and close them up using a dough wheel. For the final step, cook the ravioli in a pot of almost boiling water. Serve with melted butter and sage.
