Clubs

Now that corona regulations have become a lot more relaxed and the weather is getting warmer, this is definitely a time where you can go party. Personally, I do enjoy a good night in, but getting out of the house and having a really fun night every now and then is great. Whether these are house parties, going to a bar, or a night at a club. I live close to Munich, so my personal first club experience was in Neuraum. It's one of the biggest clubs in Munich, it has three dancefloors, the drinks are delicious and not too overpriced, and the music, as well as the visuals, are so much fun, with different DJ's also making appearances. I can definitely only recommend it if you want an exciting and fun night out. Another good club is Pacha, the music is more in the direction of electro, and feel-good house music, they also have a really nice sitting area outside. Otherwise, there is also the P1, with electronic and pop music on two 2 dance floors, as well as an outdoor seating area.

Drinks

Of course, there are all the good classics, Vodka, Jack Daniel's, Beer, etc., and all the great mixes you can do with them. Another great drink is **Gin Tonic**. Here I have two personal favorite Gins that I can recommend. One is **Illusionist**, I would drink it with a good tonic, a slice of orange, and some rosemary in the glass. It even changes color as you add the tonic. The other is **böser Kater** which is a black-berry Gin.



Make-up

You can go completely crazy with party make-up, that's the whole fun of it. It can be anything from going with natural and super simple make-up to doing a full face, with a dark smokey eye, colorful eye shadow and lips, etc. You could even draw something small on your face, put glitter everywhere, it can be anything you want. If, however you aren't sure what to do, a go-to of mine is a natural sun kissed face, with some darker eyes, usually more brownish eyeshadow, and to the outside to create a wing a darker eyeshadow, maybe add a little sparkle, and either a more natural lip, with lip gloss, or matt brown lipstick. Sometimes I'll also try colorful eyeshadow.

You basically play the game with one dice and some form of placeholder for each player, moving from the outside boxes in a spiral to the inside, and if you don't want to do what the box that you land on says, you drink.
